Dear students,

We issued new dates of examinations from Biology and Genetics 2 (B80360) using the SIS. Exams will be held in the summer semester examination period in June, during holidays (in the second half of August), and in the preterm period in September (between 2nd and 15th). The number of terms issued is final and will not be subject of any change.

The date when the registration starts, as well as the last date when cancelling the registration is possible, is highlighted in SIS. Registration for the examination is possible without first obtaining the credit; however, for taking the exam, the credit is necessary, as well as previous passing the subjects that are prerequisite for taking the examination from Biology and Genetics. Registration of a student, who will not fulfill the prerequisites, will be cancelled before the exam, during a regular check of registered students by staff members of the Institute. The student will obtain an e-mail message informing him/her about the cancellation. The student is not losing the entitlement of examination or re-examination by such cancellation.

The student who does not attend at the examination cannot enrol for another examination term without the subject principal's written consent. The student is obliged to apologize in a written or e-mail form with suitable explanation and evidence of the cause of the apology He/she will be informed about the acceptance of his/her apology. His/her registration for the exam will be cancelled when the apology is accepted. Subject principal may request further specification of the apology or its cause, if the apology is not considered sufficient.

A student can take an examination in a subject that he/she has enrolled for three times as a maximum, i.e. the student is entitled to two re-examinations. No extraordinary re-examinations (Article 68, Section 3(a) of the Higher Education Act) are allowed. The provision of first sentence does not imply that the student be entitled to a special date of examination appointed for him/her personally, even if the student did not exhaust the allowed re-examinations in the frame of available dates of examinations. The last date of examinations must not be set later than on the day before the last day of enrolment session.

The examination from Biology and Genetics consists of a written part and an oral part. When the limit of the written part (10 correct answers out of 15) is satisfied, the oral part can follow. The student draws a triplet of questions, he/she is allowed a preparatory period of 15 to 20 minutes, and proceeds to answering the questions in front of an appointed examiner. Examination questions and recommended literature are available on SIS or through the Institute web page.
